Re: Neasden Temple Visit – 13th June 2025

We are pleased to inform you that we have been able to book a visit to Neasden Temple in London for Years 3, 4 and 5 on the 13th June 2025.

The BAPS Shri Swaminarayan Mandir, popularly known as the Neasden Temple, is a Hindu temple in Neasden, London, built according to traditional Hindu architectural principles, and is a significant place of worship and cultural centre for the Hindu community in the UK

The children should be in school uniform with sensible footwear. A strict dress code operates within the complex. Specifically, tops must cover the shoulders, chest, naval and upper arms. Legwear must be at least below knee-length.

Your child will require a packed lunch and a sealable filled water bottle. To maintain the sanctity of the temple food is not permitted inside the complex so please do not send any separate snacks.

A coach has been booked and will leave school at 9.30am and leave the temple at 14.15 and we expect to back in time for the end of the school day.

The cost for the trip is £15.50 and is now available to pay via Arbor. Please provide consent and payment by 4th May 2025.
