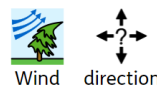
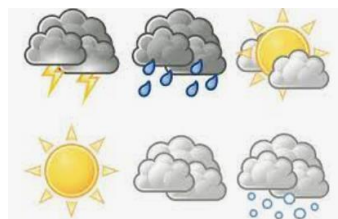
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Key Vocabulary and Spellings

1	Autumn	Leaves begin to fall from the trees.

7	Seasons	There are 4 seasons which have their own weather
8	Temperature	Measure how hot or cold something is.
