


Key Vocabulary and Spellings		
1	Plant	A living thing that usually grows from the ground.
2	Flowers	Attracts bees for pollination.
3	Leaves	Make food for the plant.
4	Roots	Allows the plant to take nutrients and water from the soil.
5	Stem	Keeps the plant sturdy and upright.
6	Evergreen	A plant or tree that keeps it leaves all year round.
7	Deciduous	A plant or tree that loses its leaves in Autumn and grows new ones in Spring.
8	Branches	Part of a tree that grows out from the trunk.
9	Trunk	Allows the tree to stand upright and supports the weight of the branches and leaves.
10	Seed	Part of a flowering plant that can develop into a new plant.
