| 1  | Segregation   | To segregate means to separate people from each other.  |
| 2  | Arrested      | Seize (Someone) by legal authority and take them to custody.  |
| 3  | Unfair        | Not based on or behaving according to the principles of equality and justice.                                     |
| 4  | Boycott       | Withdraw from commercial or social relations with (a country, organisation or person) as a punishment or protest. |
| 5  | Bravery       | Courageous behaviour or character.  |
| 6  | Activism      | The policy or action of using vigorous campaigning to bring about political or social change.                     |
| 7  | Refuse        | Indicate or show that one is not willing to do something.   |
| 8  | Civil Rights  | The rights of citizens to political and social freedom and equality.  |
| 9  | Supreme Court | The highest judicial court in a country or a state.   |
| 10 | Activist      | A person who campaigns to bring out political or social change.   |
