ROUTINES


Book bags and school reading records are to be brought into school every Friday where they will be changed.

Fruit is provided for snack Named water bottles and school uniform


PE will take place on a Tuesday and a Wednesday.







READING AND SPELLING



- Children will have an opportunity to read aloud in class daily through our daily reading lessons.
- Strategies that the children learnt to decode and blend in Year 1 will continue into Year 2 with an increased focus on pace and fluency.
- In our tri weekly ELS spelling sessions the children will continue to be exposed to all the spelling alternatives and the complexities of the English language.
- The aim for the children in Year 2 is to build up reading miles in order to build pace and fluency.

- Read and write numbers to 100 in both numerals and words.
- Partition, add and subtract two digit numbers.
- 2,5 and 10 times tables and the associated division facts.
- count in 3s.
- Recognise ½, ¼, ¼, ¾ of quantities, shapes and number
- Recognise and name 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.
- Read and interpret graphs and charts.
- Recognise pounds and pence and make the same amount of money in different ways.
