

1	Rainforests cover around 6% of the Earth's land surface.
2	It can take ten minutes for a falling raindrop to travel from a rainforest's thick canopy to the forest floor.
3	The rainforest gets at least 250cm of rain a year.
4	The Amazon rainforest has 2 and a half million different insects.
5	The two types of rainforest are temperate and tropical.
