Who are Britain's National Parks for? Finish our last 'Book Look', which was Cosmic.	Found out when each of the fifteen National Parks were awarded park status. (Compulsory)	Write a descriptive recount about a walk on/around Dunstable Downs, Ivinghoe Beacon or Wendover Woods. CHALLENGE! Explain your route in detail and even draw a map to show the way you went.	National Parks need tourism but too much can be a problem. What type of activities can you do on Dunstable Downs? CHALLENGE! Discuss the positives and negatives of over tourism.	Choose a specific natural tourist attraction and create your own model of it. e.g. Scafell Pike Old Man of Storr High Force Waterfall Malham Cove Valley of the Rocks CHALLENGE! Can you write a set of instructions to help someone else build your model?	Show your family where each of the United Kingdom's National Parks are. Explain what a National Park is and why they are so important.	Obviously I wouldn't expect you to visit a National Park, due to the distance – instead visit Dunstable Downs, Ivinghoe Beacon or Wendover Woods. CHALLENGE! Create a web page article encouraging respectful tourists to come and visit Dunstable Downs.	Investigate and research the top tourism attraction at each National Park in the United Kingdom.
