



1	Scandinavia	A group of countries including: Finland, Denmark, Sweden and Norway
2	Danelaw	The name of the area of England ruled by the Vikings after 886AD
3	longboats	Long, shallow boats used by Vikings
4	conquer	To overcome or take control
5	Norse	People of the North- Norsemen from Scandinavia
6	Lindisfarne	Also known as Holy Island, in Northumbria, where the Vikings first invaded
7	realm	Kingdoms
8	Viking	Seafaring traders and pirates from Scandinavia, who invaded Britain from the 8 th and 11 th Century and settled there
9	Danegeld	A tax created by the Anglo-Saxons to protect their people from the Vikings
10	Anglo- Saxons	A group of farmer-warriors from Europe, who lived in Britain made up of Angles, Jutes and Saxons
